Dear Landowner:

The Bureau of Reclamation has announced surface water allocations for the New Melones Unit of the Central Valley Project. The District has received a full allocation of surface water for the 2024 irrigation season. Surface Water will be available for irrigation throughout the entire growing season. Any users interested in taking surface water during the 2024 irrigation season should contact the District Office. The District's delivery of surface water beneficially addresses the over-drafted conditions of the groundwater basin and delivery of surface water this year is expected to start on or after April 15, 2024.

To update you on District activity, the District continues to work towards a merger with the Stockton East Water District. Conditions for merger have not been fully resolved. Once completed, the District will submit the requested merger to the San Joaquin County Local Agency Formation Commission. Please contact the District if you have any questions regarding the status of the merger.

Please be reminded that the District continues to make financial assistance available for surface water pumping facilities to acreage that has previously been irrigated solely from groundwater.
